General Rules

- 1. Exhibitors must purchase a Season Ticket Pass. The number on the pass will be your exhibitor number and used to issue premiums. Pee Wee exhibitors are exempt.
- 2. In all categories, there are three divisions:
 - a. OPEN- for any person who purchase a season ticket pass.
 - b. JUNIOR (under age 18) all articles must be made by Junior, and each entry (up to 25 entries) will receive a \$1.00 award. You are allowed to enter as many items as you wish but there will be a limit of \$25.00 awarded. Placing ribbons of 1-3 will be awarded in each classification with no premiums. A season ticket pass or exhibitors pass is required.
 - c. PEEWEE- exhibitors under age 8, season ticket pass is not required, but no cash premium will be awarded. If you would like the opportunity to receive a cash premium, please enter under open classes.
- 3. Exhibits may be entered on the Thursday and Friday before the fair from 2pm-7pm. Cut flower exhibits and Exhibit Gardens are the exception. Cut flowers may be entered from 7:30am to 9:00am Saturday morning. Exhibit Gardens may be built 12:00 noon to 7pm Thursday and Friday. Exhibits will be in place until Tuesday at 4pm when they may be removed. Items left after 8pm Tuesday will be handled appropriately, unless other arrangements are clearly made with the director.
- 4. **All exhibits in this department must be grown by the exhibitor,** with the exception of flower arrangement materials.
- 5. Judging takes place in the individual class, not overall category.
- 6. Unlisted or "other" varieties will be judged together unless there are more than 3 entries of the same variety.
- 7. Exhibits showing noticeable insect or fungus issues at the time of judging will be disqualified.
- 8. First, Second, and Third places of each class will be awarded. **PREMIUMS: 15T-\$5 2ND-\$3** 3RD-\$2

Exhibit Gardens

- 1. 1st, 2nd, 3rd places awarded ribbons. 1st place is the only recipient of cash premium. 1st place wins \$50.
- 2. Each exhibitor may enter into one class.
- 3. Gardens must have a title and map identifying the plants and their location in the garden.
- 4. Gardens should convey practical and creative ideas that can be replicated by the viewers
- 5. Show area for gardens in 10'W x 10' D.
- 6. Organization must furnish all items and materials for their garden.
- 7. Exhibitors must pre-register by the Monday before the fair to ensure space. Contact Destiny at (740)525-7797.
- 8. All plants must be live, no faux plants allowed.
- 9. "Yard Décor" such as statues, garden lights, fountains, and metal art is allowed.

Entries may be fresh or dried plant material, or a mix of both. Only dried plant material may be painted. No faux plants allowed.

Dish Gardens and Fairy Gardens

- 1. Exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor for no less than 90 days.
- 2. Exhibitors may enter up to 2 entries per class, **but** entries in the same class must have at least 2 different varieties. Example: Dish 1 has Creeping Jenny, Scotch Moss, and Dwarf Myrtle. Dish 2 in has Spider Plant, Hens and Chicks, and Dwarf Myrtle.
- 3. Dish Gardens must have a minimum of 3 different species. Accessories are permitted.
- 4. Fairy Gardens must have a minimum of 3 different species. At least 3 accessories are mandatory.

CUT FLOWERS AND FOLIAGE

- 1. Exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor.
- 2. Exhibitors may enter up to 2 entries per class, **but** entries in the same class must be of different varieties or cultivators.
- 3. Use transparent glass bottles or vases for the entries. Colored glass is allowed.
- 4. <u>PLEASE SPECIFY VAREITY ON TAG FOR OPEN CLASSES.</u> If more than 3 of the same variety are entered, those entries will be judged in their own class.
- 5. Relevant Definitions:
 - a. Disbudded- removal of all excess buds from the stem but not removing healthy leaves.
 - b. Single Stem- 1 bloom on the stem, all other blooms removed and disbudded.
 - c. Spray- a branching stem with multiple blooms, no blooms or buds removed unless necessary for presentation.
 - d. Cluster- 3 stems of flower, either the same or mixed colors.
 - e. Single Stalk- 1 stem of a stalk flower
